Dr James is an Honorary Senior Lecturer at the University of Oxford. He is a consultant child and adolescent psychiatrist at the Highfield Unit, Oxford. He has research interests and published on early onset psychosis, bipolar disorder, OCD and dialectic behavioural therapy (DBT) and eating disorders. He helped set an inpatient CBT-E service. Dr James has been on two UK NICE Guideline Development Groups, including one on Schizophrenia and Psychosis in young persons and another on Bipolar Disorders. Currently, he is involved in a clinic for adolescents with treatment resistant depression (TRD) and a NIHR (National Institute of Health Research) trial for clozapine in adolescents and young adults under 25.
