Dr Nathan Huneke is a Psychiatrist and Clinical Lecturer at the University of Southampton, UK. Dr Huneke received his MBChB with honours and MRes with distinction from the University of Manchester in 2013. He was subsequently awarded a PhD in Clinical Neurosciences from the University of Southampton in 2023, with a thesis exploring the psychoneurobiology of the placebo response in gambling, depressive, and anxiety disorders.

Dr Huneke's current research is focussed on understanding the mechanisms that cause anxiety and affective disorders, which he explores through the use of experimental medicine models, psychophysiology and neuroimaging. He is also interested in understanding the mechanisms of placebo and nocebo responses in clinical trials for patients with mental disorders. He was awarded the British Association for Psychopharmacology Junior Clinical Psychopharmacology Award in 2020 and was a Highly Commended Academic Researcher by the Royal College of Psychiatrists in 2023.
